Each year the **International Day of Peace** is observed around the world on the 21st of September. The UN General Assembly has declared this as a day devoted to strengthening the ideals of peace, through observing 24 hours of non-violence and cease-fire.

Celebrate peace by standing up against acts of domestic violence, and by spreading compassion, kindness, and hope in the face of the pandemic.

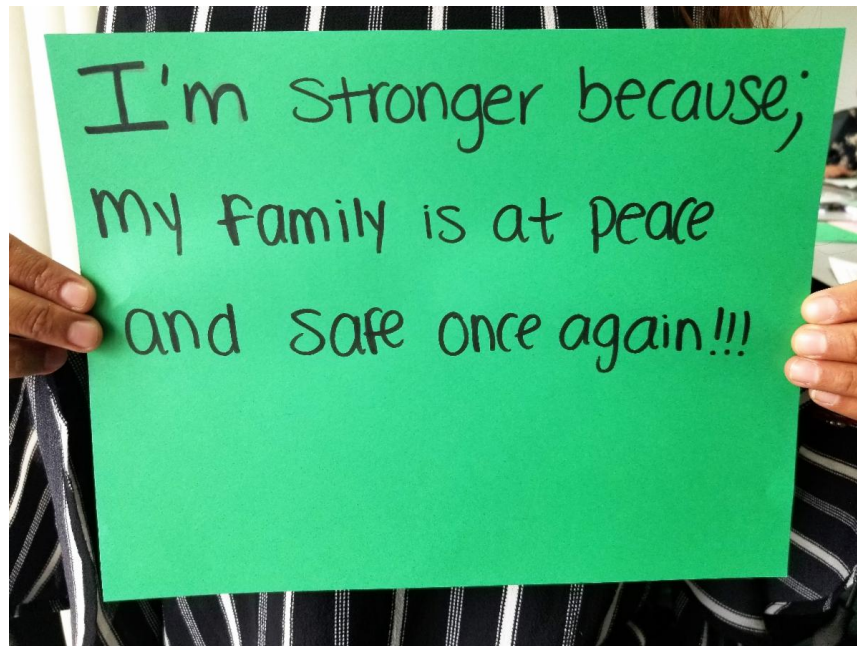
