### **Sexual Violence & Pride Month**



"For ALL Survivors"

Crisis House works to eliminate all forms of sexual and domestic violence. The month of June – Pride Month – reminds San Diegans to be aware of and to help to stop incidents of sexual assault in the LGBTQI+ community.

Pride Month is a movement that celebrates sexual diversity. For lesbian, gay, bisexual and transgender (LGBTQI+) people it is a way of promoting their dignity, equal rights, self-affirmation and is a way of increasing society's awareness of the issues they face.

LGBTQI+ individuals face increased risks of sexual assault. In fact, according to the CDC's National Intimate Partner and Sexual Violence Survey, 44% of lesbians and 61% of bisexual women experience sexual violence from a partner. LGBTQI+ individuals face unique challenges to healing from sexual assault due to barriers to access to resources, especially medical and legal

resources.

Crisis House offers emergency housing, confidential counseling, services to ALL survivors of sexual assault and domestic violence.

## **ECHC** serves the Santee Riverbed



"We as a community are only as strong as our weakest link."

Crisis House's East County Housing Connections (ECHC) Homeless Outreach Mobile Outreach Team provides services to those who are most vulnerable and often forgotten in our community. Every Thursday morning, ECHC and the County of San Diego team up to provide resources to clients living in the Santee riverbeds.

The number of homeless people camping in and around Santee has increased over the past year, according to a recent report. In fact, for the entire 15.5 miles of the San Diego River bed, from Santee to the Pacific Ocean, the count of homeless people came in at an estimated 201, compared to 158 in 2020.

Although the process of transforming the life of someone experiencing homelessness is often long and nuanced, Crisis House helps individuals secure identification cards and other legal documents.

Thanks to supporters like you, in 2020 Crisis House was able to permanently house **78 individuals**, **including 21 children** experiencing chronic homelessness who would otherwise not have access to shelter.

We are so proud of our ECHC Mobile Outreach Team and grateful to all of those who have donated to make this dream a reality!

## **Meet our Crisis House team**


